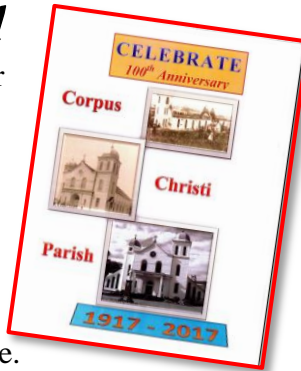

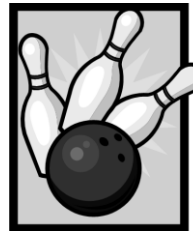
Souvenir Books!
