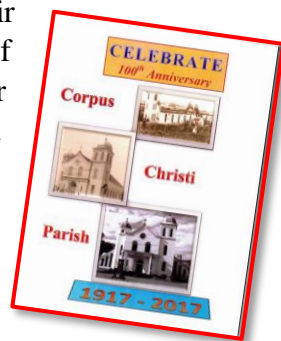

weekend of Oct 14/15.**

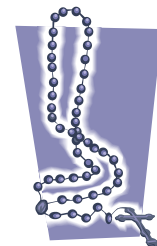
**K of C Brunch**
